\* "Discussion" = No expectation of a final decision. The Council cannot discuss City issues as a group outside of a public meeting without violating the Kansas Open Meeting Act.

#### INTRODUCTION

Under the Kansas Open Meetings Act (KOMA), the public has the right to observe the meetings of the Towanda City Council unless the City Council has recessed into a lawfully conducted executive session. The KOMA does not require the opportunity for public comment – that opportunity is provided at the discretion of the City Council, except as required by State law or City ordinance in certain specific circumstances. This policy outlines the various circumstances under which the City Council meets and elaborates on the City Council's Rules of Procedure by addressing the rules regarding the time, place, and manner of public participation in the City Council meetings from the standpoint of the participating member of the public. This policy is intended to strike a lawful balance between First Amendment protections and the substantial public interests of (1) assuring that meetings of the City Council can occur in an efficient, orderly, and safe manner and (2) promoting productive public discourse regarding the governance and administration of the City while maintaining decorum in an environment free from interference, distraction, or intimidation, whether real or perceived, by any person present in the meeting room toward the Council or members of the public.

#### SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN INFORMATION

Written information may be submitted to the City Clerk before noon on Thursday prior to a City Council meeting for distribution to Council and key staff members or may be presented during the meeting upon recognition by the Mayor as a speaker in the manner described below. Ten (10) copies should be provided to ensure that all applicable parties are able to receive and review the information provided.

# FORMS OF COMMUNICATION OR EXPRESSION NOT ALLOWED IN THE MEETING ROOM

To assure fulfillment of the substantial public interests outlined above, no member of the public attending the City Commission meeting shall in the meeting room engage in the following forms of communication or expression found by the City Council to be in conflict with the substantial public interests outlined above and, therefore, not allowed in the meeting room (the "disallowed conduct"):

# Before, during, or after the meeting:

(1) Possessing, placing, or displaying a sign, placard, flag, or banner, regardless of its size, the material of which it is made, or its written, graphic, or symbolic content;

#### **During the meeting:**

- (2) Audibly speaking, or making any sound or noise other than while speaking as a speaker recognized by the mayor;
- (3) Applauding, whistling, cheering, clapping, or otherwise expressing agreement with a speaker recognized by the mayor;

- (4) Booing, jeering, taunting, ridiculing, mocking or otherwise expressing disagreement with a speaker recognized by the mayor;
- (5) Inaudibly mouthing or gesturing messages deemed to be distracting to other persons in the meeting room;
- (6) Making available or distributing written materials to those in attendance.

Persons attending a City Commission meeting must turn off or set on vibrate all cellular telephones. Any person exhibiting any form of the disallowed conduct will first be warned by the Mayor to cease. If the person continues the disallowed conduct, the Mayor may ask the person to leave the meeting room. If the person does not promptly leave the meeting room, the Mayor may direct that the person be escorted from the meeting room.

# **AGENDA ITEMS**

#### **CONSENT AGENDA**

The Consent Agenda assembles routine action items for collective approval in the interest of efficiency of the meeting. Any item may be removed from the Consent Agenda for separate consideration either (a) at the request of a Council Member or City staff, or (b) by a majority vote of the City Council upon request by a Towanda resident directed to City staff or to a Council Member prior to the start of the meeting without discussion.

#### PRESENTATIONS AND GUEST SPEAKERS

Presentations and Guest Speakers Time is an opportunity for organizations or citizens to make special presentations before the City Council. Such are scheduled in advance of the meeting by calling the City Clerk Andy Newbrey at (316) 536-2243 by 5:00 pm the Thursday preceding the meeting. Presentations are limited to ten minutes. Any presentation is for information purposes only; no action will be taken.

#### PUBLIC HEARINGS AND REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

Following the introduction of any public hearing or regular agenda item, consideration of the item will ordinarily begin with a staff report followed by Council Member questions of staff. If the matter involves an applicant, the applicant or the applicant's representative will be given the opportunity to address the City Council.

In the case of a public hearing, the public hearing shall be conducted in the manner required by State law or Towanda ordinance and any person entitled to address the City Council shall be provided that opportunity, regardless of his or her viewpoint on the matter, subject to the allowed time period.

In the case of a regular agenda item, subject to the discretion of the City Council, any interested persons wishing to address the City Council regarding the subject of the agenda item, regardless of his or her viewpoint on the matter, may be given the opportunity to do so, subject to the allowed time period.

In the case of either a public hearing or regular agenda item, those allowed to address the City Council may do so by, in turn, approaching the podium to be recognized by the mayor.

- Upon recognition by the Mayor, the speaker must indicate his or her name and city of residence and may address the subject of the agenda item for no longer than the allowed time period which is typically three (3) minutes but may be altered and announced by the Mayor based upon the number of persons expected to speak during the public hearing or regular agenda item.
- While addressing the City Council, the speaker may request permission from the Mayor to distribute any written information regarding the subject of the agenda item to City Council Members, the City Administrator/City Clerk.
- The speaker should avoid repeating what has already been said and should feel free to simply state whether he or she is or is not in support of the matter being discussed.
- A speaker should not expect to engage in two-way dialogue with the City Council.
- A speaker should provide his or her comments for Council consideration at their discretion.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT TIME

Public Comment Time provides an opportunity for Towanda citizens to address the City Council on a topic that is not on the meeting agenda.

# After the Mayor announces the Public Comment Time:

- Any citizen wishing to address the City Council should, in turn, approach the podium to be recognized by the Mayor.
- There are no residency requirements.
- Upon recognition by the Mayor, the speaker must indicate his or her name and city of residence and may address the City Council for no longer than the allowed time period which is typically three (3) minutes but may be altered and announced by the Mayor based upon the number of persons expected to speak during the Public Comment Time.
- While addressing the City Council, the speaker may request permission from the Mayor to distribute any written information to Council Members, the City Manager, and the City Clerk.
- The City Council is not expected to take immediate action in response to the presentation.
- At the discretion of the City Council, subjects introduced under Public Comment Time may be referred to City staff for follow-up or may become an agenda item for a future meeting.
- A speaker should not expect to engage in two-way dialogue with the City Council.
- A speaker should provide his or her comments for Council consideration at their discretion.
  - o Comments or questions will be directed **only** to the City Council.
- Debate or arguments between parties in the audience is not allowed.
- Comments on personnel matters and matters pending in court are not permitted.

In order for the Council to have an opportunity to review comments in advance of the meeting, please email your comments or questions to <a href="mailto:administrator@cityoftowanda.com">administrator@cityoftowanda.com</a> by 5:00 p.m. the Tuesday prior to the Wednesday meetings.

#### **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

The Kansas Open Meetings Act allows the City Council to recess into an executive session based upon certain justifications outlined in the act. The City Council may recess into executive session based upon a motion that includes (1) a statement describing the subjects to be discussed during the executive session, (2) the statutory justification for the executive session, and (3) the time and place at which the open meeting shall resume. Executive sessions are closed to the public, however, once the executive session has concluded, members of the public may return to the meeting room.

#### **AGENDA INFORMATION**

Copies of the agenda are available on the Friday afternoon preceding the regular meetings. Items for the agenda should be submitted to the Towanda City Clerk's office prior to noon on the Thursday preceding a regularly scheduled Wednesday meeting. Information regarding the agenda may be obtained from City Hall, 110 S. 3<sup>rd</sup>, Towanda, KS, or by visiting our website at: www.citvoftowanda.com/agendas-minutes

# **OTHER ITEMS**

#### STUDY/WORKSHOP SESSION

The City Council may meet in study session on topics determined by the City Administrator or the City Council on a specific date and time. As the name suggests, the study/workshop session is intended to provide a less formal opportunity for the City Council to study, discuss, and provide direction to City staff regarding the subject under study. Study sessions are open to the public; however, the extent of public participation is subject to the discretion of the City Council based upon available time during the study session and the need for public input in order to accomplish the objectives of the City Council in studying the subject of the study session.

#### SPECIAL LIMITED PUBLIC FORUM

A special limited public forum may be called by the City Council for the purposes of

- (a) conducting public discussion and
- (b) seeking public comment and/or the submission of written information regarding a particular subject matter.

A special limited public forum may be convened in the City Council's regular meeting room or at an alternative, publicly accessible site suitable for the anticipated number of participants in the forum.

At the appointed time on the agenda, any persons wishing to address the City Council regarding the subject of the special limited public forum, regardless of their viewpoint on the matter, may do so by, in turn, approaching the podium or microphone to be recognized by the Mayor.

 Upon recognition by the Mayor, the speaker must indicate his or her name and city of residence and may address the subject of the special limited public forum for no longer than

the allowed time period determined and announced by the mayor based upon the number of persons expected to speak during the forum.

• While addressing the City Council, the speaker may request permission from the Mayor to distribute any written information regarding the subject of the special limited public forum to the City Council, the City Administrator, and the City Clerk.

# RE: New Ordinance for the Regulation of Vacant Residential Buildings (Ordinance for approval)

Prepared for this meeting is an Ordinance for the regulation of Vacant Residential Buildings. We have had an instance or so stemming from vacant residential structures in the city.

# RE: Update of Zoning Regulation Fees (Resolution for Approval)

At the Planning Zoning Meeting of February, after much deliberation and discussion, the PZ Board approved an increase to the Zoning/Subdivision Regulation Fees which had not been revised since 1998. They are asking for your approval of the Resolution to increase these fees.

# RE: Updating of 1997 Towanda Zoning Regulations (FYI)

The week of February 10<sup>th</sup>, Foster & Associates plans to provide a timeline for the process to update the Towanda Zoning Code.

There will be an extensive amount of research for the Zoning Department to provide Ordinances and changes that have been added to the regulations since 1997 to be included in the update.

# RE: Building Code Effectiveness Grading Schedule (FYI)

A meeting has been scheduled here for February 26th with a representative of ISO from Verisk to evaluate our Building Code Enforcement Program. The data required includes Building Code Enforcement, Inspection Information, Zoning Appeals, permits issued in the previous year and the process to review them, employee data and qualifications, departmental operations, and enforcement of Flood Plain Regulations. Also reported is the edition of the adopted Building Code Models in effect.

This information is used widely by the insurance industry to set rates for our community and utilized by FEMA for various grant programs. The last ISO evaluation for Planning & Zoning was in 2019.

# RE: Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) 2024 Grant (FYI)

On January 30th, we received word that the FEMA Grant 1, had applied for, to monetarily assist the city in updating the Building Codes and/or Zoning Regulations, had passed the pre-application process, and was approved to be forwarded to the next phase.

On February 3<sup>rd</sup> we received word that there was a funding pause on the FEMA Grant. We are awaiting further instructions.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF VACANT RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS PROVIDING PROCEDURES RELATED TO MAINTENANCE, MARKETING AND ANNUAL INSPECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body Towanda finds that vacant residential real estate adversely affects quality of life, creates blight, and impacts local property values; and

WHEREAS, vacant residential buildings are known to attract vandalism, become havens for drug use and other crime, and require expenditure of public funds for police protection, fire protection and housing inspection; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Towanda finds that public health, safety and welfare are adversely affected by prolonged vacancies in residential real estate;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Towanda, Kansas:

SECTION 1. The Governing Body of Towanda, Kansas, hereby adopts a vacant residential building ordinance as follows:

# Section 1.

# (a) Purpose

Recognizing that vacant residential buildings contribute to blight in residential neighborhoods, discourage economic development and retard appreciation of property values, endanger public health and safety, attract criminal activity, and create fire hazards, it is the responsibility of property owners to prevent buildings from becoming a burden to the neighborhood and community and a threat to the public health, safety, and welfare. Maintenance of the public health, safety, and welfare thus requires the City to maintain an accurate registration of all vacant buildings and properties.

# (b) Definitions

- (1) 'Building' means a residential building, accessory structure, mobile or modular structure, or other structure adapted to permanent occupancy for residential purposes;
- (2) 'City' means the City of Towanda;
- (3) 'Chronic Vacancy' means any building or property vacant for an uninterrupted term of 1 year or more after initial registration
- (4) 'Owner' means the person, persons or entity identified as the owner of the parcel with the Butler County Appraiser's Office; or any agent identified by a nonresident owner;
- (5) 'Residential' means any "residential structure or property" as defined in the Towanda Zoning Regulations;
- (6) 'Unsecured' means that access to the building may be obtained through open, unlocked, broken or missing doors or windows of such building;

(7) 'Vacant Building' means a building or property that is unattended or unoccupied and is not actively used as a place of residence, or the building is frequently open or unsecured so that unauthorized admittance may be gained without damaging any portion of the property. A residential property will be considered vacant when found to be in the above condition for more than twelve consecutive (12) months and subject to the registration requirements found in Section 2.

# Section 2.

# (a) Registration and maintenance requirements; fees

- (1) The owner of a vacant building or property must register the building with the City designated officer within twenty (20) days of written notice provided to the owner or the owner's resident agent of the existence of the vacant building. Such notice shall be served on the owner or resident agent by personal service or by certified mail, return receipt requested. If the owner is a non-resident, such notice shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of the owner;
- (2) The City shall also accept notifications by mail or electronic transmissions of a building or property that meets the definition of a Vacant Building or Property as defined in Section 1-(b) -7 and shall pursue registration of said building/property in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.
- (3) The required registration shall be submitted on the form provided by the City, which form shall include the name, current mailing address, phone number and any other contact information of the owner; the names and addresses of all known lien holders and all other parties with a legal or equitable ownership interest in the building; and the common address of the building. The form shall also include the period of time the vacant building is expected to remain vacant, and a plan and timetable for either:
  - (i) returning the vacant building or property to appropriate occupancy or use; or
  - (ii) marketing the property pursuant to the requirements of subsection (b) of this ordinance;
- (4) Pursuant to the registration requirements of this subsection, for every subsequent year a building remains vacant beyond the initial registration, the owner of the vacant building must:
  - (i) re-register the building or property, including appropriate fees, and
- (ii) submit an updated plan for either returning the vacant building or property to appropriate occupancy or use, or marketing thereof;
- (5) If the owner of the vacant building or property does not reside in Butler County for at least six (6) months a year, then they must provide the information for a resident agent with authority to act with respect to the property, including \name, current mailing address, phone number and any other contact information of the owner's agent;
- (6) Any subsequent owner of a vacant building or property must register or reregister the building with the City designated officer within thirty (30) days of any transfer of any ownership interest in the vacant building;
- (7) The owner of a vacant building or property must keep the building and any adjoining property secure, safe and maintained in compliance with all federal, state and local ordinances and regulations;
- (8) A registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per residential building shall be collected by the City designated officer at the time of registration or re-registration.

# (b) Marketing requirements

The following vacant buildings or properties shall be exempt from the registration fee required pursuant to Section 2(a)(9), but shall still comply with all other registration requirements under this section:

- (1) All buildings which are actively marketed as "for rent" in a newspaper or in a recognized online website listing at a fair market value rental rate based upon market rental rates for comparable properties. It is the responsibility of the vacant building owner to produce evidence of active marketing to claim this exemption. In the event that active rental marketing ceases, the vacant building in question shall be subject to the registration fees provided for above and shall immediately be due and owing;
- (2) All buildings or properties which are being actively marketed as "for sale" by a licensed real estate broker or by the owner and advertised as such in a newspaper or listed on a recognized online website. The vacant building owner has the obligation to produce evidence of active marketing in order to obtain this exemption. In the event that the active "for sale" marketing ceases, the vacant building in question shall be subject to the registration fees provided for above and shall immediately be due and owing
- (3) Any vacant residential building for which the owner executes a valid affidavit on a form provided by the City attesting that the owner intends to resume occupancy of the vacant building as a dwelling within 180 days. Failure to actually resume use of the vacant building as a dwelling within 180 days will result in the reinstatement of the registration fee that was exempted under this section;
- (4) An owner who acquires a vacant building or property for which the registration fee has already been paid for the calendar year period shall register the change of ownership with the City, but is not liable for an additional registration fee for that calendar year.

# Section 3.

# Penalties; procedures

- (1)(a) Any owner who fails to register a vacant building under this ordinance, as required by Section 2, may be liable for a civil penalty not to exceed <u>fifty dollars (\$50.00)</u>.

  (b) If the building continues to meet the definition of a vacant building for a period of ninety (90) calendar
- days beyond the required registration or re-registration date, and the owner fails to register or re-register such building, the City designated officer may assess a penalty of one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each ninety (90) calendar day period the building continues to be unregistered. At no time may the amount of the assessment exceed four-hundred dollars (\$400.00) per building in a calendar year.
- (c) If a building or property is vacant more than 1 year after initial registration it shall be classified as a chronic vacancy and shall be subject to a fee of \$200.00 per year . Funds derived from said fee shall be used to offset the city's cost of annual inspections as found in Section 2 of this ordinance.
  - (d) All penalties assessed shall be payable directly to the City.
- (e) Any and all civil penalties assessed under this section shall be billed to the owner or other responsible party. Failure or refusal to pay any and all such penalties permits the City to pursue any and all available legal remedies for the enforcement and collection of such penalties; including but not limited to, civil actions being filed in district court, suits or actions being maintained in any court of competent jurisdiction, abatement of nuisances maintained in violation of this Ordinance, institution of injunction, mandamus, or other appropriate action or proceedings to enforce the penalty provisions of this Ordinance.
- (2)(a) Upon failure to register a vacant building, as required by Section 2, a Notice of Registration Penalty may be issued to the owner;
- (b) A separate Notice of Registration Penalty shall be issued for each subsequent penalty that may be assessed pursuant to Section 3(1);
- (c) The Notice of Registration Penalty shall be served upon the owner by certified mail or personal service.
- (d) This ordinance in no way limits the penalties, actions or abatement procedures which may be taken by the City for a violation of any other ordinance of the City or statute of the State of Kansas

## Section 4.

Annual inspection requirement for structures or properties classified as chronic

- (1) The City designated officer or their appointee may inspect or cause to be inspected any premises in the City for the purposes of enforcing and assuring compliance with the provisions of this chapter and safeguarding the health, safety and welfare of the general public. Upon the request of the City designated officer, an owner shall provide access to all interior portions of any vacant building or suspected vacant building in order to permit a complete inspection;
- (2) The Fire Chief is authorized to enter and inspect, or cause to be inspected, all vacant buildings and premises for the purpose of conducting an annual fire code compliance inspection.
- Section 5. Should any paragraph, section or subsection of this ordinance be declared to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
- Section 6. The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of the City of Towanda, Kansas, as an addition or amendment thereto, and shall be appropriately numbered to conform to the Uniform Numbering System of the Code.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication in the official City newspaper.

# A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR CHARGES FOR PROCEEDINGS GOVERNED BY THE ZONING REGULATIONS AND SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF TOWANDA, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Towanda has adopted Zoning Regulations and Subdivision Regulations which create the need for a fee schedule to wholly or partially defray the costs for administration and enforcement of such regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized pursuant to K.S.A. 12-757 (a) to establish reasonable fees to be paid in advance by the owner of any property at the time of making application for a zoning amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized pursuant to K.S.A. 12-759 (a) to establish a scale of reasonable fees to be paid in advance by applicants for cases heard by the Board of Zoning Appeals; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized pursuant to K.S.A. 12-752(d) to establish a scale of reasonable fees to be paid by the applicant for each plat filed with the Planning Commission;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOWANDA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the following fees are hereby established for the purpose of wholly or partially defraying costs for proceedings under the City Zoning Regulations for amendments to zoning district classifications and for special use applications:

Amendment to District Classification	\$275.00
Special Use Application	\$275.00 *

<sup>\*</sup> If an amendment to a district classification and a special use application are concurrently processed for the same zoning lot, only one fee is to be charged which would be the higher of the two fees listed.

If notifications have been given for an amendment to a district classification for a special use application and the applicant requests a deferral of the hearing, the applicant will be charged the direct cost of renotification.

Section 2. That the following fees are hereby established for the purpose Of wholly or partially defraying costs of proceedings before the City Board of Zoning Appeals for appeals from the determination of the Zoning Administrator,

If notifications have been given for an appeal, variance or conditional use and the applicant requests a deferral of the hearing, the applicant will be charged the direct cost of renotification.

Section 3. That the following fees are hereby established for the purpose of wholly or partially defraying costs of administration and enforcement under the Zoning Regulations for various permits and certificates:

If there is a failure to apply for a zoning permit prior to commencing the construction, structural alteration, enlargement or moving of a structure or the establishment, change to another, extension or enlargement of a use which upon investigation would otherwise have been permitted by the Zoning Regulations, there shall be an investigation charge added to the above permit fee which doubles the cost of the fee.
