INTRODUCTION

Under the Kansas Open Meetings Act (KOMA), the public has the right to observe the meetings of the Towanda City Council, unless the City Council has recessed into a lawfully conducted executive session. The KOMA does not require the opportunity for public comment – that opportunity is provided at the discretion of the City Council, except as required by State law or City ordinance in certain specific circumstances. This policy outlines the various circumstances under which the City Council meets and elaborates on the City Council's Rules of Procedure by addressing the rules regarding the time, place, and manner of public participation in the City Council meetings from the standpoint of the participating member of the public. This policy is intended to strike a lawful balance between First Amendment protections and the substantial public interests of (1) assuring that meetings of the City Council can occur in an efficient, orderly, and safe manner and (2) promoting productive public discourse regarding the governance and administration of the City while maintaining decorum in an environment free from interference, distraction, or intimidation, whether real or perceived, by any person present in the meeting room toward the Council or members of the public.

SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN INFORMATION

Written information may be submitted to the City Clerk before noon on the Thursday prior to a City Council meeting for distribution to Council and key staff members or may be presented during the meeting upon recognition by the Mayor as a speaker in the manner described below. Ten (10) copies should be provided to ensure that all applicable parties are able to receive and review the information provided.

FORMS OF COMMUNICATION OR EXPRESSION NOT ALLOWED IN THE MEETING ROOM

To assure fulfillment of the substantial public interests outlined above, no member of the public attending the City Commission meeting shall in the meeting room engage in the following forms of communication or expression found by the City Council to be in conflict with the substantial public interests outlined above and, therefore, not allowed in the meeting room (the "disallowed conduct"):

Before, during, or after the meeting:

(1) Possessing, placing, or displaying a sign, placard, flag, or banner, regardless of its size, the material of which it is made, or its written, graphic, or symbolic content;

During the meeting:

- (2) Audibly speaking, or making any sound or noise other than while speaking as a speaker recognized by the mayor;
- (3) Applauding, whistling, cheering, clapping, or otherwise expressing agreement with a speaker recognized by the mayor;
- (4) Booing, jeering, taunting, ridiculing, mocking or otherwise expressing disagreement with a speaker recognized by the mayor;
- (5) Inaudibly mouthing or gesturing messages deemed to be distracting to other persons in the meeting room;
- (6) Making available or distributing written materials to those in attendance.

Persons attending a City Commission meeting must turn off or set on vibrate all cellular telephones. Any person exhibiting any form of the disallowed conduct will first be warned by the Mayor to cease. If the person continues the disallowed conduct, the Mayor may ask the person to leave the meeting room. If the person does not promptly leave the meeting room, the Mayor may direct that the person be escorted from the meeting room.

AGENDA ITEMS

CONSENT AGENDA

The Consent Agenda assembles routine action items for collective approval in the interest of efficiency of the meeting. Any item may be removed from the Consent Agenda for separate consideration either (a) at the request of a Council Member or City staff, or (b) by a majority vote of the City Council upon request by a Towanda resident directed to City staff or to a Council Member prior to the start of the meeting without discussion.

PRESENTATIONS AND GUEST SPEAKERS

Presentations and Guest Speakers Time is an opportunity for organizations or citizens to make special presentations before the City Council. Such are scheduled in advance of the meeting by calling the City Clerk Andy Newbrey at (316) 536-2243 by 5:00 pm the Thursday preceding the meeting. Presentations are limited to ten minutes. Any presentation is for information purposes only; no action will be taken.

PUBLIC HEARINGS AND REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

Following the introduction of any public hearing or regular agenda item, consideration of the item will ordinarily begin with a staff report followed by Council Member questions of staff. If the matter involves an applicant, the applicant or the applicant's representative will be given the opportunity to address the City Council.

In the case of a public hearing, the public hearing shall be conducted in the manner required by State law or Towanda ordinance and any person entitled to address the City Council shall be provided that opportunity, regardless of his or her viewpoint on the matter, subject to the allowed time period.

In the case of a regular agenda item, subject to the discretion of the City Council, any interested persons wishing to address the City Council regarding the subject of the agenda item, regardless of his or her viewpoint on the matter, may be given the opportunity to do so, subject to the allowed time period.

In the case of either a public hearing or regular agenda item, those allowed to address the City Council may do so by, in turn, approaching the podium to be recognized by the mayor.

- Upon recognition by the Mayor, the speaker must indicate his or her name and city of
 residence and may address the subject of the agenda item for no longer than the allowed time
 period which is typically three (3) minutes but may be altered and announced by the Mayor
 based upon the number of persons expected to speak during the public hearing or regular
 agenda item.
- While addressing the City Council, the speaker may request permission from the Mayor to distribute any written information regarding the subject of the agenda item to City Council Members, the City Administrator/City Clerk.
- The speaker should avoid repeating what has already been said and should feel free to simply state whether he or she is or is not in support of the matter being discussed.
- A speaker should not expect to engage in two-way dialogue with the City Council.
- A speaker should provide his or her comments for Council consideration at their discretion.

PUBLIC COMMENT TIME

Public Comment Time provides an opportunity for Towanda citizens to address the City Council on a topic that is not on the meeting agenda.

After the Mayor announces the Public Comment Time:

- Any citizen wishing to address the City Council should, in turn, approach the podium to be recognized by the Mayor.
- There are no residency requirements.
- Upon recognition by the Mayor, the speaker must indicate his or her name and city of residence and may address the City Council for no longer than the allowed time period which is typically three (3) minutes but may be altered and announced by the Mayor based upon the number of persons expected to speak during the Public Comment Time.
- While addressing the City Council, the speaker may request permission from the Mayor to distribute any written information to Council Members, the City Manager, and the City Clerk.

- The City Council is not expected to take immediate action in response to the presentation.
- At the discretion of the City Council, subjects introduced under Public Comment Time may be referred to City staff for follow-up or may become an agenda item for a future meeting.
- A speaker should not expect to engage in two-way dialogue with the City Council.
- A speaker should provide his or her comments for Council consideration at their discretion.
 - o Comments or questions will be directed **only** to the City Council.
- Debate or arguments between parties in the audience is not allowed.
- Comments on personnel matters and matters pending in court are not permitted.

In order for the Council to have an opportunity to review comments in advance of the meeting, please email your comments or questions to administrator@cityoftowanda.com by 5:00 p.m. the Tuesday prior to the Wednesday meetings.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Kansas Open Meetings Act allows the City Council to recess into an executive session based upon certain justifications outlined in the act. The City Council may recess into executive session based upon a motion that includes (1) a statement describing the subjects to be discussed during the executive session, (2) the statutory justification for the executive session, and (3) the time and place at which the open meeting shall resume. Executive sessions are closed to the public, however, once the executive session has concluded, members of the public may return to the meeting room.

AGENDA INFORMATION

Copies of the agenda are available on the Friday afternoon preceding the regular meetings. Items for the agenda should be submitted to the Towanda City Clerk's office prior to noon on the Thursday preceding a regularly scheduled Wednesday meeting. Information regarding the agenda may be obtained from City Hall, 110 S. 3rd, Towanda, KS, or by visiting our website at: www.cityoftowanda.com/agendas-minutes

OTHER ITEMS

STUDY/WORKSHOP SESSION

The City Council may meet in study session on topics determined by the City Administrator or the City Council on a specific date and time. As the name suggests, the study/workshop session is intended to provide a less formal opportunity for the City Council to study, discuss, and provide direction to City staff regarding the subject under study. Study sessions are open to the public; however, the extent of public participation is subject to the discretion of the City Council based upon available time during the study session and the need for public input in order to accomplish the objectives of the City Council in studying the subject of the study session.

SPECIAL LIMITED PUBLIC FORUM

A special limited public forum may be called by the City Council for the purposes of

- (a) conducting public discussion and
- (b) seeking public comment and/or the submission of written information regarding a particular subject matter.

A special limited public forum may be convened in the City Council's regular meeting room or at an alternative, publicly accessible site suitable for the anticipated number of participants in the forum.

At the appointed time on the agenda, any persons wishing to address the City Council regarding the subject of the special limited public forum, regardless of their viewpoint on the matter, may do so by, in turn, approaching the podium or microphone to be recognized by the Mayor.

- Upon recognition by the Mayor, the speaker must indicate his or her name and city of residence and may address the subject of the special limited public forum for no longer than the allowed time period determined and announced by the mayor based upon the number of persons expected to speak during the forum.
- While addressing the City Council, the speaker may request permission from the Mayor to distribute any written information regarding the subject of the special limited public forum to the City Council, the City Administrator, and the City Clerk.

- Mayor Jennifer Shaults, 7:00 pm

4. Presentation and Guest Speakers

5. Department Reports

- Planning and Zoning
 - Mike Hayes inquired about Pine Ridge regarding extensions. Zoning Administrator Lisa Long stated that she is allowing extensions as long as there is progress being made. They also are to call her each week with updates.
- Towanda Fire Rescue
 - Kendall Pierce brings up talking with the Ellinwood City Administrator/Ex Fire Chief in regards to grants. Kendall stated there might be many grants available, which might be another avenue for us. TC Pyle states that he has previously talked with Chief in Derby as far if there were any other grants and states that his wife has recently found one to look into. Right now, the grants are very competitive. Kendall Pierce states that he could maybe get a list of grants that the Ellinwood City Administrator/Ex Fire Chief has obtained to see if any will help the City of Towanda.
 - TC Pyle also states that he worked on plans, and included a picture, but the plan was shut down. TC Pyle states that he needs a plan in order to go after grants. Mayor Shaults states that she looked at the plans that he had presented but that it would be tough to sell. States there is only a small amount. TC Pyle states the contract already in place needs to change. Kendall Pierce states that they should

be working with the Township and getting a plan together. Mayor Shaults agrees and states that they need to have a board to come together with a plan. Mayor Shaults suggests the Fire Board is a good start and maybe should include one person from each township, one person from city council, and some citizens who are interested and will put in the time. Further discussion in the matter brings forth maybe putting together a committee. Andy Newbrey brings up the plans that were submitted, he is taking two of them to get costs for a starting point and direction.

- Towanda Maintenance Department
 - Sam French and Andy Newbrey announced that the meter installation was completed and that the meter is working.

6. Old Business

- School Zone Signs Update
 - Updates announced by Andy Newbrey that the updates to the school zone signs would be worked on during the winter break. Discussion takes place as far as the location of the signs. Counsel reviewed the diagram provided by Lisa Long, which shows a proposed start and end for the school zones. Budget is discussed on where the funds will come from to pay for the updated school zone signs. Street Reserve fund was proposed but then suggested that if funds are still available in the ARPA funds, to use that. (Motion by Mike Hays to authorize and approve the school zone lights/signs. Second by Jeff Banks. Motion carried 5-0)
- City/School Banners Update
 - Andy Newbrey discussed the totals for the proposed banners for the city. States the proposed costs for 34 banners, the school will pay for ½. A question is asked on the reason for the banners to which Andy Newbrey states it is a good reason to build community pride between the City and schools. (Motion by Jeff Banks to approve the purchase of 34 banners up to a total not exceeding \$3500. Second by Mike Hays. Motion carried 5-0)
- Sheriff's Contract update
 - Counsel discusses a proposed contract put together by City Attorney Rob Lane. Mike Hayes challenges the system and wants a survey to go out to the city for their impute. (Motion by Kendall Pierce to approve and pass the proposed contract that will be presented to the Sheriff's Office by Andy Newbrey. Second by Bill Wolf. Motion carried 3-2)
- Pine Ridge Meter Updates
 - Previously discussed with the department reports

7. New Business

- Revised Water & Trash Pricing for Mobile Home Communities
 - With the meter being changed out, there will be a change in the trash and water rates. Resolution number 2023-12 sets new pricing. The complication is that we are billing for one massive number instead of an individual number. Based on the formula that Andy Newbrey has created, the pricing structure will come close to matching what residents would be billed for water usage for this side of town.

9. Public Comment

- Kit Willans asks a question in regards to the maintenance of the fire hydrants. Upon stating where the housing is located, Sam French lets him know that the fire hydrant in question is currently broken.
- Kurt Reeves wants to update the Counsel on the water surveys that went out. He states that the rental properties that he owns, the tenants are just throwing them away and wanted to find out how to get those completed. Andy Newbrey states that they were aware that probably a lot would be thrown away but that he can log onto the website and complete/submit the surveys for each owned property.
- Nicole Mandina states she comes to all the meetings and enjoys them. However, there have been talks about the Sheriff contract at numerous meetings but no proposal until now. She states she is a concerned citizen in regards to Sheriff Safety and thinks that more surveys would be helpful in finding out what the people want.

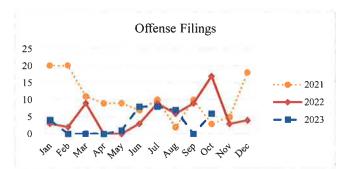

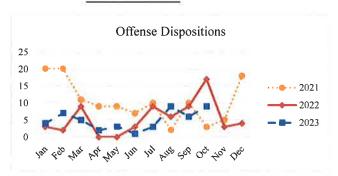

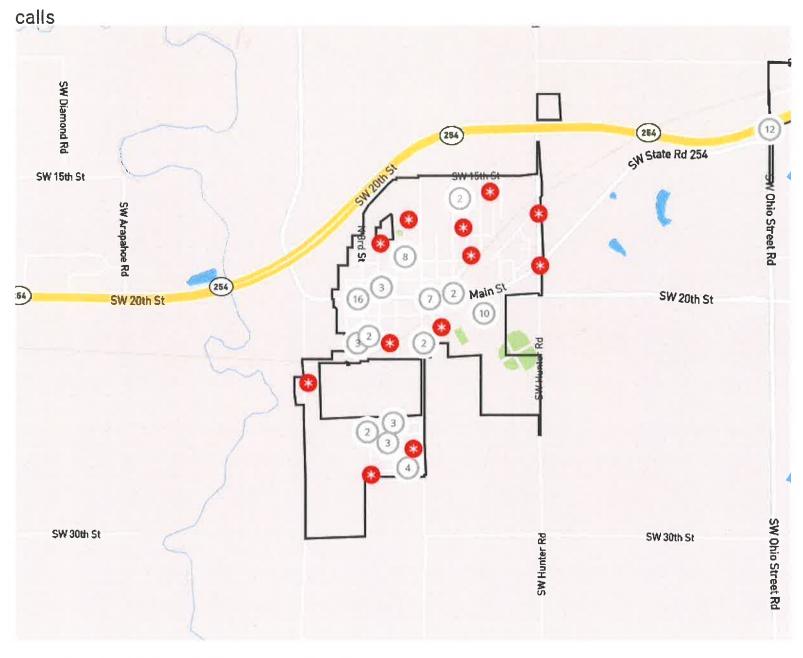

Summary:

Towanda Fire Rescue is still the busiest (and geographically smallest) volunteer Fire Department in Butler County. TFR responded to 42 calls in October bringing the YTD total to 285. Volunteers continue to work many hours: 633 in October, 6600 YTD. TFR still needs a bigger station that will house reliable fire engines, brush trucks, a squad and tankers, along with a training room, showers, kitchen, and more. Through the efforts of their volunteers TFR has been awarded approximately \$50,000 in grants in the past 18 months. In the past 8 months, about \$16,000 has been collected through fundraising activities and community outreach.

Equipment:

- Engine 1: This truck still has electrical gremlins. Air conditioning (and heating) has also been an on-going intermittent issue.
- Engine 3: This truck has questionable reliability. It should be replaced. A good, used truck was located for about \$450,000. Discussed lease purchase with City Admin. Interest rate is 7.5% for 10 years. Unfortunately, the truck sold already. If we want to pursue a used fire engine purchase, we need a plan to spend the money, so if in the future another opportunity arises, we can act BEFORE the truck is sold. With delivery of new trucks being pushed out for 2-3 years, the used market is getting very active.
- Pumper 4:
- Pumper 5: Received grant to get new pump assembly, but the pump will likely go to Pumper 6 since we cannibalized P6 pump to get P5 pump back in service. Several of our wildland equipment pumps (and engines) are near (or over) 30 years old. Tires are out of date. Original military tires (within date) are not available. At this time it appears our best option is to buy 10 new wheels and tires to replace the current tires. Estimate is \$6500.
- Pumper 6 (out of service) Requested quotes for getting the truck back in service: \$64,000.
- Pickups: PU8 & PU9:
- Tanker 12: Sitting outside in freezing cold. Almost all water outside the city limit must be hauled. Having this truck out of service (drained of water and extremely difficult to start) hampers fire suppression efforts.
- KSFM Grant. We received notification of award on Nov 1. The award is for 2 sets of coat and pants at \$5365.42.
- Radios: The 12 new handheld radios acquired in the past 16 months are doing fine, but we have 18 older radios. The older XTS radios are obsolete. They may no longer function in 2 years when new standards come into effect. We currently have 6 portables (handhelds) and 11 mobile (vehicle and base) radios that will need replaced at some time in the fairly near future. Plan on spending about \$150,000. This money is not currently in the budget!

Building:

Due to lack of space and dilapidation, the emergency responders serving the Towarda and Fairview communities need a new facility in order to better serve.

The school district is growing. The highways are more congested. The population is expected to increase. Calls continue to increase.

As has been stated, the contract with Towanda Twp. is a potential roadblock to any improvement of the fire department. The percentages do not reflect the interests of all parties involved—only the City and Towanda Twp. It ignores contributions of:

Fairview Twp

Butler County (communications--radios, communication system, etc.) Donated equipment: (Federal surplus property, other fire departments) Monetary donations to the fire department

Furnished Equipment (BuCo Emergency Medical Service supplies, other) Equipment purchased with grant monies (through the efforts of volunteer firefighters)

Volunteer Firefighter labor (build & maintain trucks and building, training, community support, write grants, submit reports, respond to calls, raise funds, etc., etc.)

- Home School Day at the Museum brought students from the museum to the Fire Station for a lesson and water spraying. All appeared to enjoy the Station activities (Thank you to FF Linda Pyle and Lt. Alecia Darrow).
- Chief Pyle attended the Monthly Chiefs meeting on Oct. 5 in Douglass.
- FFs L. Pyle, K. Ash and Captain Storm presented Fire Prevention training at Towanda Elementary School on Oct 10 multiple times.
- Chief Pyle attended the Forestry Service Wildfire Risk Assessment training on Oct. 10 in Wichita
- Four members attended an After Action Review of a critical event in order to communicate each agency's thought processes. It was interesting to hear the multiple 911 calls reporting the incident and hear how difficult it often is for dispatchers to determine what is happening. (None of the calls matched what we found when we arrived.) All agreed, the agencies worked well together. The patient outcomes were not affected negatively. A few tweaks were recommended to improve efficiency which should be simple to implement (except in CAD. CAD is never easy).
- On October 10, firefighters were in house when paged to a tragic scene. We were proud of our quick response, but in this case we were not able change the outcome.

- Chief Pyle attended the Task Force Chiefs meeting on Oct. 16 in Whitewater.

Have you ever wondered? Why are Fire Departments concerned with response times?

One of the metrics fire departments are graded on is the time it takes to get to a call. The time starts when the call is received and stops when they arrive on the scene. Response time is important because free-burning fires double in size every 30 seconds. Medical emergencies can have dire consequences as well with a delayed response. It always preferable to have trained responders in of near the trucks they respond in to minimize this time.

What do volunteer firefighters like to do?

They like responding to calls, solving problems. They like being around the big trucks. They like to hang around with other emergency responders to tell stories, share what they've learned with others.

A fire station is a great place to do these things.

Volunteer firefighters also like to watch sports. They like to eat. They like to hang out together.

Again, a fire station is a great place to do these things.

Wouldn't it be great if the firefighters were in the station all the time? Ready to respond?
